



PLAYER HELPER JOB DESCRIPTION

POSITION – PLAYER HELPER (GB NATIONAL TEAM)

OBJECTIVE: Under the guidance of the British Para Ice Hockey Association, perform the Player Helper duties for the Great Britain National Team

QUALIFICATIONS

- Strong background in working with disabled athletes.
- Strong interest and commitment to athlete development.
- Ability to work with fellow coaching personnel.
- Ability to communicate on and off-ice requirements to players and parents.
- Available to meet time requirements.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Act on direction of the team head coach and report directly to the team head coach.
- Assist the assigned player(s) with movement around the Airport / Hotel / Transport / Competition Venue.
- Assist with movement of player equipment from the Locker Room to/from the Playing Area.

AREAS OF EXCLUSION

- Locker Room Access is not permitted unless invited in by a Coach
- Team Meeting Access is not permitted unless invited in by a Coach
- Player Bench access during tournament games is not permitted unless invited by the Team Medic or a Coach.
- Access onto the field of play is not permitted.
